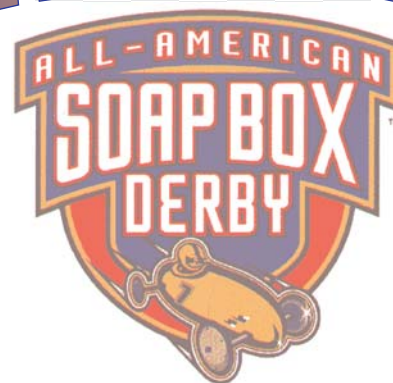

And a "Soap Box Derby" it was christened back in 1933, when a Dayton (Ohio) Daily News Photographer encountered three boys racing home-made, engine-less cars down an inclined brick street.

Cleveland has been a part of Soap Box Derby Racing since 1934 and is one of only three cities to have participated continuously in Soap Box Derby since the beginning. Recently in 2001 with the support of many area sponsors, a permanent track was built along the Shoreway just west of downtown Cleveland. This world class racing track is the pride of our organization.



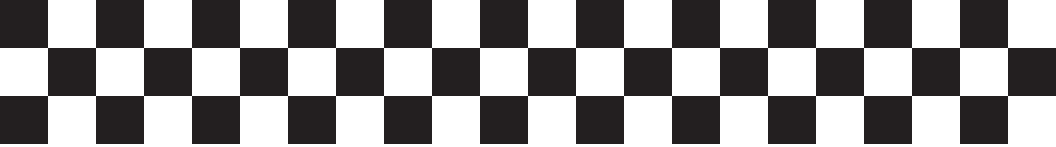

Build and race your own Derby car...

Soap Box Derby Racing is a great family activity for boys and girls age 8-16* The goals of the Soap Box Derby program are to promote families working together, to teach youngsters some of the basic skills of workmanship; along with the spirit of competition while developing traits such as self confidence, perseverance and craftsmanship.

Cars are assembled from kits for all three of the racing classes of Soap Box Derby. All cars must be built to the specifications established by the All- American Soap Box Derby Association. Kits are available for purchase through the All-American Headquarters in Akron, Ohio. Car kits start at around \$500. Keep in mind that your employer, local companies or organizations will often sponsor a car and cover some or all of the cost. Racing Classes...



Stock: The Stock car class is designed for the novice racer age 8 to 13. Stock cars are the least expensive and are the simplest to assemble. The weight limit for the Stock class is 200 lbs including the car and child.

Super Stock: The Super Stock class is intended for drivers who are 10 years old and are more experienced or can no longer fit into a stock car. This car is more aerodynamic and has a larger cockpit. The weight limit for this class is 230 lbs including the car and child.



Masters: The Masters class is intended for the advanced builder and driver who is 10 years old and has been driving for a number of years and is usually but not always older. Unlike the Stock and Super Stock divisions, the driver lays down while driving this car. The weight limit for this class is 255 lbs including the car and child.

Special Needs: This class is intended for children with special challenges. We have pre-built dual control cars for interested youngsters to race at no cost.

Derby Racing

Cleveland has a number of races each year. Rally races for points are spread throughout the year and also held in other cities and states throughout the country. Each year the Cleveland Local Championship race is held in June and the winners are eligible to compete in the All-American and NDR National Championship races held in July.
